Site Terms & Conditions (TOS)

1 - Acceptance

These Use of Site Conditions determine the rules of access to the site and its conditions of use.

Simply because of their connection to the site the user agrees to accept these terms unconditionally and undertakes to respect them.

2 - Content

The term Site Content = the general structure of the website, the graphics, all content on this site (images, articles, photographs, logos, trademarks, videos, interviews, sounds, text, databases, newsletters ...).

The content is protected by the legislation in force in France including intellectual property, copyright, related rights, trademark law, the right to the image, and by international law.

Any representation and / or reproduction and / or total use (s) or part (s) of this site and its contents, by any means whatsoever, for any reason whatsoever, without the prior express consent of the FFM, is prohibited and constitutes an infringement punishable by Articles L335-2 including and following the Code of Intellectual Property, and / or an act of unfair competition and / or parasitism act likely to engage the responsibility of the people having committed them.

3 - Licence to use site content

By their mere connection to the site, the user agrees to accept from the FFM a licence for use of the site content strictly limited to the following mandatory requirements:

4 – French Law on Information Technology, Files and Freedom

The website has been declared to the French Commission for Information Technology and Civil Liberties (CNIL) and also to the Paris District Court public prosecutor.
